



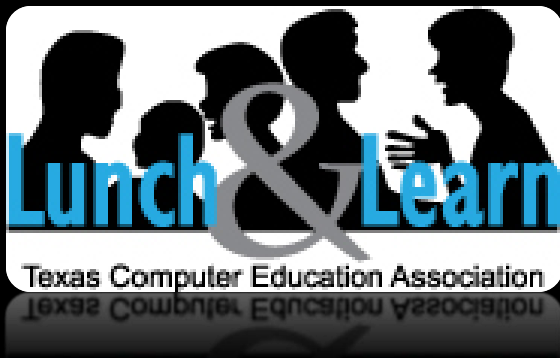

1. Read RFP very carefully
2. Make it EASY for the evaluator
3. PUSH through the wall
4. DOUBLE-CHECK final copy
5. Find a STRANGER
6. Include all the PEOPLE
7. EVALUATE Explanation
8. CELEBRATE
